Here are some of the ways we are making a measurable difference:



63% of our ongoing consumables are green certified or environmentally preferred products.

60% of our food suppliers are local producers & growers, injecting more than \$550,000 back into the local economy.





Our rooftops gardens and permaculture help to absorb heat, offset the urban heat island effect and reduce carbon emissions through cooling.

Approximately 5,288 MEALS donated to the Edmonton Food Bank's Second Helping program.

In 2018, we eliminated our use of plastic straws, diverting an estimated 253,00 straws from landfills.



We were the first conference venue in Canada to be Green Key Level 5 certified.



129 local artists are showcased through our community art initiatives every year.



45 pounds of honey was harvested from our rooftop apiary in 2018.

We are working to use less energy and water and emit less carbon and waste to reduce our building's footprint each year.




DID YOU KNOW?

In 2018, we participated the Climate Smart Carbon Accounting Inventory using the GHG Protocol for the first time—helping us reduce our carbon emissions in alignment with the City of Edmonton goals of reducing 35% by 2035.
